[Immediate Release] Videotage(HK), in collaboration with Denny Dimin Gallery(U.S.), presents *Hong Kong: Tales of the City*, a panorama of Hong Kong video art development by showcasing a series of Hong Kong artists across generations from **13 March to 18 April 2020** at **Denny Dimin Gallery, New York**. Curated by **Isaac Leung**, *Hong Kong - Tales of the City* connects international and local artists to collaboratively explore the social and political dimensions of the city.

An Outlook of Hong Kong Video Art brought to New York

In our times where society and modern life are intensely transforming and evolving in the context of globalization, cities are developing in a more and more similar pattern yet embracing differences in local culture and socio-political systems. Hong Kong and New York, regarded as the symbol of modern east and west respectively, not only demonstrate how world cities are progressing and sharing a more inclusive path forward but also facing common global challenges.

Hong Kong - Tales of the city will present various contemporary tales with the inspired works of **9 Hong Kong video artists**, depicting and exploring how the two faraway places connect and interact across the west-east boundary in responding to major global issues concerning PUBLICNESS, EVERYDAYNESS, and QUEERNESS in the context of contemporary Hong Kong society.

Hong Kong Video Art: from Pioneers to Millennials

HONG KONG - Tales of the City brings together a selection of video artworks by Hong Kong artists, from video art pioneers active since the 1980s to artists born in the 1990s, reflecting the city's video art development spanning over 30 years. From the video art pioneer Ellen Pau to

mainstay media artists Chilai Howard and Lee Kai Chung, to emerging artists of the next generation Joseph Chen and Ip Wai Lung, the line-up paints the pictures of the Hong Kong video art scene in reflection to the changing society in different eras.

The entire fascinating cross-cultural project comprises two video art exhibitions in two cities, Hong Kong and New York. The Hong Kong parallel exhibition TALES OF THE CITY - VIDEO ART IN HONG KONG AND THE U.S. in collaboration with Denny Dimin Gallery, Hong Kong will present 10 talented American and Hong Kong artists by the end of 2020, under the theme of social and political life in a cross-cultural context. In 2003, Leung received an Honorary Fellowship of a Bachelor of Fine Arts at the New Media Art Department of the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. In 2013, Leung was appointed as the Chairman of Videotage. During his tenure, he initiated and participated in projects that included exhibitions, workshops, lectures, publications, online projects, and symposia. Some of these include 40 Years of Video Art in Germany and Hong Kong (Hong Kong and Germany), The 12th Venice Biennale International Architecture Exhibition (Italy and Hong Kong), Perpetual Art Machine (USA), Time Test – International Video Art Research Exhibition (China), ISEA Festival (Hong Kong, China), Both Sides Now (Hong Kong, UK, and various countries), Loop Barcelona (Spain), One World Exposition (Hong Kong), China Remixed (USA), Clockenflap (Hong Kong), and Art Basel Crowdfunding Initiative (Hong Kong). Leung has taught at the Education University of Hong Kong Polytechnic University. He is currently Assistant Professor BA program in Cultural Management, The Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Denny Dimin Gallery is a contemporary art gallery founded by Elizabeth Denny in 2013. We opened as Denny Gallery that January on the Lower East Side of New York City.
