Amanda Valdez works in a matrix of gestures, styles, and materials referring to visual cultures that are both western and non-western. Valdez pulls on a variety of histories, from quilting and sewing, to tiling and brick-laying, to virtuoso gestural painting. Her works operate as a reflection of the body, and the histories that the body holds in its physical makeup: scars, sags, symmetries and asymmetries, and a lifetime of emotions.

Amanda Valdez received her MFA from Hunter College in New York City and BFA from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago.

Her most recent solo exhibition was *Piecework* at the Heckscher Museum of Art (2020). Her next solo exhibition will be at Denny Dimin Gallery (Spring 2021).


Her work is included in the collections of the Mead Art Museum at Amherst College and the Davis Museum at Wellesley College.







Justine Hill's work explores the boundaries of abstract painting with her unique approach to form and mark making. She styles her paintings on shaped wood panels wrapped in canvas. Hill began to work with this process in 2015 when she was questioning the circumscribed boundary of the single rectangle for a painting.

Hill received her MFA from the

University of Pennsylvania and her BA from the College of the Holy Cross. Hill's most recent solo exhibitions were *Touch* at Denny Dimin Gallery (2020) and *Pull* at MAKI Gallery in Tokyo (2020). In 2019, she collaborated on a ballet duet titled *Shapeshifters* with choreographer Michelle Thompson Ulerich as part of *Counterpointe7* organized by Norte Maar in Brooklyn.



Born 1975 in Chicago, IL. Lives in Carrizozo, NM.


Paula Wilson is a mixed-media artist who studies and sources imagery from different cultures, geographies, and times to develop a unified, visual language of her own. Wilson frequently combines printmaking, painting, sculpture and video into her projects. Wilson works by collaging multiple forms of visual language together: ancient motifs, tropes from Western art history, and identifiers of her home in the High Desert.

Watch Jessie Edelman introduce her work



Born 1986 in Milwaukee, WI. Lives in Brooklyn, NY.

Jessie Edelman's paintings generate layers of fictional spaces, which may be film screens, paintings, photos, or distant vistas, often including a human subject in the foreground witnessing the scene alongside the viewer. The exuberance of Edelman's colors and elegance of her brushwork are echoed by the timeless Mediterranean-esque locations, such as views from poolside of a

villas on a bluff or opulently decorated seaside terraces. Late 19th century and early 20th century artists such as Cézanne, Degas, and Rothko have stylistically influenced her work. She is equally informed by the development of visual culture that occurred in this period and is ongoing today.

Edelman received her MFA from the Yale School of Art in 2013. She had solo exhibitions at Denny Dimin Gallery (New York, NY), Andrew Rafacz Gallery (Chicago, IL), and a two-person exhibition (with David Humphrey) at The Suburban (Milwaukee, WI). Her work has been reviewed or featured in *i-D Magazine*, *The Art Newspaper*, *Vice*, *Brooklyn Magazine*, *Artnet News*, and *Vogue*
